
2026 ParBoilers Partner Better Ball Championship

June 27, 2026

- Tournament Seeding will be determined by random lottery with previous year's Better Ball Finalists awarded the ONLY seeds.
- Entry Fee, (\$40 per team)
- Matches must be played once a month or a forfeit will be declared. Participants shall make every possible attempt to play the match and may upon agreement amongst themselves play at an alternate site other than a ParBoilers Golf Club tournament but the match must be played by the Sunday before the first tournament of the next month.

ParBoilers Partner Better Ball Tournament Rules:

- Play to be completed in the month scheduled.
- Format is NET Better Ball. Double pops are awarded on par 3s in Better Ball matches but NOT in ParBoiler Net skins.
- The team with the low Better-Ball score wins the hole.
- There is no maximum handicap stroke differential between Better Ball Partners.
- Better Ball Matches will be played to **100% of Current Index** with 'stroke holes' awarded per course handicap difference off Low-Man in the foursome:

Example: Team # 1 has **Player A** (11 handicap) and **Player B** (24 handicap)
Team # 2 has **Player C** (4 handicap) and **Player D** (15 handicap)

Since **Player C** has the lowest handicap (4) in the foursome, **Player C** will play to a Zero handicap. **Player A** will receive 7 strokes (11-4), on holes 1-7. **Player B** will receive 20 strokes (24-4), 2 on handicap holes 1 & 2 and one stroke on 2 through 18. **Player D** will receive 11 strokes (15-4), on holes 1 through 11.

- **Tiebreaker** will follow normal ParBoilers Tiebreaker procedures.
Gross score card-off beginning at hole number 10 (thru 18, then 1 thru 9 if necessary).
YES, that is correct - **Gross** Score. If your team loses hole #10 GROSS, then you will need to beat your opponent outright or you will lose in a card playoff.
- Partner B can play first, even though partner A is away.
- Partners can give advice to each other until the match is final. Once the match is over partners cannot give advice to each other.
- If your ball is deflected by your partner or equipment, (including a cart you are sharing), you are disqualified for that hole, but not your partner.
- If one player on a team is late or does not show up at all, the remaining player may play against the other team. The missing player may join the match in progress at the start of any hole.
- Championship match **MUST** be played at the Winter Classic.

The preferred location to play Better Ball matches is at a ParBoilers event. However, the match may be played at any mutually agreed upon location. There must be a match winner reported to the committee before the tournament of the next month. Review your schedule; contact your opponents if you will not be at all events to verify they will be at the event you plan on attending.

NOTE: In addition to your Better Ball match, you are also playing in the ParBoiler Net Tournament against 40 other members. Although your opponent may concede a putt or a hole in your Better Ball match, you **MUST** play out the hole to the bottom of the cup, or be **disqualified** from the Net Tournament, Low Putts and that Hole's Gross & Net Skin.
