
2026 ParBoilers' Club Championship

January 1, 2026

- 2026 ParBoiler Club Championship entry: \$15
- Tournament entry open to ParBoiler Members with 2026 dues paid
- PB Club Championship matches will be played to the Player's current **SCGA Index**
- First Round matches to be played in January 2026
- 2026 ParBoiler Club Championship Prize Pool:
 - 1st: \$TBD 2026 PB Membership & SCGA Tournament of Club Champions entry
 - 2nd: \$TBD 2026 PB Membership
 - 3rd: \$TBD
 - 4th: \$TBD
- ParBoiler Player-of-the-Year points, (1 point for entry, plus 1st = 5, 2nd = 4, 3rd = 3, 4th = 2, 5th - 8th = 1)
- All Matches **to be played in the month scheduled**. If for any reason you will not be at BOTH scheduled events in a month, you must contact your opponent to verify that he will be at the event you are planning to attend. If you & your opponent cannot make a common event, participants may upon agreement play at an alternate site. It is preferred that matches be played at ParBoiler events with forfeits being awarded to the competitor making the most ParBoiler events in the applicable month.
- Stroke holes will be awarded per **course handicap difference**, (**NOT** as strokes fall on card).
Example:
Player A (19 handicap) vs. Player B (24 handicap) 24 - 19 = 5
Player B will receive 5 strokes from Player A on Handicap Holes # 1 thru # 5
Player C (5 handicap) vs. Player D (34 handicap) 34 - 5 = 29
Player D will receive 29 strokes, 2 on handicap holes 1 thru 11, and 1 on 12 thru 18.
Note: Club Championship plays to True Handicap, (if handicap # 9 is a Par 3, Player D gets 2 strokes).
- **Tiebreaker** will follow normal ParBoiler Tiebreaker procedures.
Gross score card-off beginning at hole number 10 (thru 18, then 1 thru 9 if necessary).
YES, that is correct - **Gross** Score. If you lose hole #10 GROSS, then you will need to beat your opponent outright or you will lose in a card playoff.
- **Rule 2-4, Concession of Next Stroke, Hole or Match**
When the opponent's ball is at rest or is deemed to be at rest under **Rule 16-2**, the player may concede the opponent to have *holed* out with his next *stroke*. A player may concede a hole or a match at any time prior to the conclusion of the hole or the match. Concession of a *stroke*, hole or match may not be declined or withdrawn.
ParBoiler Exception to Rule 2-4
The PBCC is Match Play and although **Rule 2-4** applies to PBCC matches, it is important to remember that you are also competing in a STROKE play tournament and Skins game with 40 other ParBoiler members. ParBoilers play the ball to the bottom of the cup, there are "NO gimme" putts, and USGA Stroke Play rules apply at all ParBoiler events.
Stroke Play Rule 3-2, Failure to Hole Out
If a competitor fails to *hole* out at any hole and does not correct his mistake before he plays a *stroke* from the next *teeing ground* or, in the case of the last hole of the round, before he leaves the putting green, **he shall be disqualified**.
